

## **FAQ for Series 63, 65, and 66 changes which take effect on 1/1/10**

### **1. What's changing?**

#### **Series 63:**

Number of questions on Securities reduced from 15 to 6

Number of questions on Registration of Persons increased from 18 to 24

Number of questions on Unethical Business Practices increased from 21 to 24

Passing score increased to 72%

No changes to content, per NASAA

#### **Series 65:**

New content, mainly on capital market theory and types of accounts

Number of questions on Unethical Business Practices reduced from 45 to 40

Passing score increased to 72%

#### **Series 66:**

New content as in the S65

Weighting of questions changed from 80% Legal and 20% Investments to 50/50

Passing score increased to 75%

### **2. Will RegEd issue updated materials?**

New Study Guides will be shipped starting in mid-January. For candidates who have materials issued prior to the new books being released, a supplemental document detailing all changes will be available starting in the last week of December. A candidate who has an older Study Guide will not need to order new books; the supplemental document together with the materials they have will be sufficient.

Online practice exams will be updated to reflect new exam topic breakdowns, content, and passing scores in January. Students who have had tests assigned before these changes were implemented will need to be assigned new exams.

CD-ROMs will expire on December 31, 2009. Students using CD-ROMs purchased before January 1, 2010 should contact customer service to have new CDs sent or request online exams.
