

DOI Mandates Email Address Update — Going Paperless July 1st

What it Means

While a number of states are talking about it, the paperless office is here with both California and Florida Departments of Insurance.

California

On July 1st California will cease issuing paper licenses. Once a license is issued, all communication with a producer will be strictly electronic, using an email address that is provided and maintained, by the producer. Therefore, California mandates that all producers go to the CA DOI website and add, verify, or update their email address.

Florida

Florida is also implementing a paperless office this year, but has not yet set an effective date. Florida producers are also required to go to the Florida DOI website and add, verify or update their email address. Florida has also indicated that it is their intention, when the paperless office becomes effective, to implement the license policy they have used in the paper world. That is, returned mail will result in suspension of a producer's license. Therefore, it is essential that producers maintain a current email address with Florida. Neither state has established batch processing for email updates. Each producer must log into the state database and update their email address individually.
